

A DAY WITH MARY ASSOCIATION

You are invited to enrol in the Day With Mary Association. This will make you a direct participant and beneficiary of the activities and spirituality of this apostolate. To become members of the DWM means to make a personal commitment to participate personally and actively in the supernatural work of the Immaculate Herself, "to give to Her our entire selves in accordance with Her intentions, without limits", in accordance with our own maximum personal specific possibilities. Members also benefit from the prayers, sacramental life and activities of the DWM Apostolate and the religious communities of Franciscan Friars and Sisters of the Immaculate (F.I.) in the world. To enrol in the DWM involves personal active commitment to one's own personal duties as well as receiving benefits, as listed here below: these two aspects co-exist inseparably.

Members will:

- 1. support the Association with their prayers,**
- 2. participate in DWMs in accordance with their own possibilities and circumstances,**
- 3. pray the Rosary daily (minimum 5 decades),**
- 4. fulfil the devotion of the five first Saturdays of the month (you have to be a Roman Catholic to be able to do this),**
- 5. wear the Brown Scapular and the Miraculous Medal,**
- 6. Holy Mass is offered for the members' intentions twice yearly in churches pre-announced and receive by post the annual list of DWMs,**
- 7. both the living and the dead may be enrolled; the souls of the departed benefit by way of suffrage from the prayers and sacraments of the Franciscans of the Immaculate and the Day With Mary Apostolate.**
- 8. offer a yearly donation in support: a minimum of £3.00/yearly is suggested.**

This amount may be reviewed from time to time.

It is the responsibility of the member to fulfil the above commitments, taken personally with the Immaculate. The validity of the enrolment is in perpetuity, unless: a) it is expressly cancelled by the member; b) the yearly donation (*in accordance with one's own possibilities*) is no longer made, (*except in cases of personal financial hardship in which case the validity of association continues*); c) the Association ceases to exist. If you wish to enrol another person it is necessary that you receive his/her previous permission to do so. When you enrol you are given a plasticised personal membership card of the Day With Mary. No receipt is given, neither is your annual donation checked, as these are part of a member's personal responsibilities as explained above.
